Rogelio undertook the enormous task of organising, with great success, the 5th Regional Conference which took place in Panama City, in March 2004. He also worked with Jack Batievsky in the organisation of the Cuzco Regional Conference. A very good friend to many of us at the IBA, Rogelio was a leading corporate tax lawyer in Panama. Under his leadership and after, Rogelio put a lot of effort into the development and proliferation of the successful activities of the IBA throughout the region, including the Tax Committee.

- (1) The Jack Batievsky Scholarship and the Rogelio de la Guardia Scholarship to attend the Biennial IBA Latin American Regional Forum Conference from 14–16 March 2018 is free to enter. It is open to all lawyers up to and including the age of 35 whether or not they are members of the IBA.

- (3) Applications should be written in English and be accompanied by a 2,500 word paper on one of the following topics, focusing on Antitrust: a new era in the battle for control over consumers' information; Beyond Lava Jato and the Panama Papers; Innovation, startups and intellectual property management; Protectionism in M&A transactions; Tax evasion, elusion and money laundering; Technology and the future of real estate; The growth of green energy; Traditional banking v crowdfunding; and What will stay the same in alternative dispute resolution?
 - Papers must be original, unpublished works. They will not be under consideration for any Commercial Contract by any publishing house. The author is warranting his/her restricted copyright to the paper submitted. **Applicant's names, firms, email addresses and other details must not appear on their submitted articles.**
- (4) Applications must be submitted and received by 4 DECEMBER 2017. Applications received after this time will not be considered.
- (5) All applications will be submitted to the Scholarship Committee which will consist of IBA Latin American Regional Forum Officers. They will judge the papers primarily on the basis of legal argumentation, research, style, logic, originality and overall quality of the content.
- (6) It is planned that the IBA Office will communicate the conference selection panel decision to the successful applicant by **8 JANUARY 2018**.
- (7) The decision of the judging committee is final and no correspondence will be entered into. The decision will be published on the IBA website. The successful applicants will be contacted at the email address given on the application form.

- (13) The IBA has the right to publish a selection of the papers submitted, including but not limited to the winning paper (either the full text or extracts thereof); this includes but is not limited to the publication in the conference documentation and/or on the IBA website and/or other IBA publications. In any event, the name of the author will be indicated appropriately. Authors shall include a biographical note giving details of their legal career, studies and professional appointments. Papers received that are not in this form may not be considered.
- (14) If you are awarded a scholarship please note that proficiency in English is mandatory and you will be required to provide evidence that you are able to practise law.
- (15) Participants will be expected to have read and accepted all the above rules.
